HIGHLIGHTS

TRAINING OUTPUT (Enrolled and Graduates)

- For the year 2020, there are 802,218 Enrollees and 715,158 Graduates with an 89% completion rate.
- There is a 68% decreased in the number of enrollees and graduates compared to the 2019 output, which is 2,488,922 and 2,240,750, respectively.
- TESDA NCR has the highest number of enrolled and graduates while BARMM recorded the lowest number of enrolled graduates.
- In terms of the number of enrollees and graduates, TESDA NCR has the highest output while BARMM take the lowest spot.
- However, TESDA Region II takes the highest spot in terms of the percentage output against the 2020 target with a 161% accomplishment rate in terms of the number of graduates.
- TESDA Region VII and NCR fall short to even reached a 50% accomplishment rate against its 2020 target.
- The Institution-based type of training delivery has the most number of output among the 4 types of training delivery which covers 42% of the total number of enrollees.
- Top 3 performing sectors are Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery (18.47%); Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (14.81%); and Electrical and Electronics (8.16%) while Logistics and Footwear and Leather-goods obtained the lowest training output.
- Public provider has the most number of enrollees and graduates compared to the output from the private provider.
- Among the TVET Scholarship programs, the Training for Work Scholarship Program (TWSP) reported the highest number of output with 46,102 graduates.
- Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant), and Metals and Engineering have the most number of enrollees and graduates based on the scholarship program outputs
- Out of the 2020 Enrolled and Graduates output, a total of 181,065 enrollees and 146,029 graduates are from the TTIs, which is 23% and 20% of the national output.
- TTIs located in region VI reported the highest output among the region.

- Students, Farmers and Fishermen, and Indigenous People and Cultural Communities accounted the highest number of beneficiaries in terms of number of enrollees and graduates

ASSESSMENT AND CERTIFICATION

- There are 493,018 assessed and 462,189 certified individuals and with 94% certification rate.
- Similar to the number of enrolled and graduates, TESDA NCR has reported the highest number of assessed and certified individuals while CARAGA has the least output.
- Among the regions, TESDA NCR obtained the lowest percentage output, which is 60% accomplishment against 2020 target of the region.
- TESDA BARMM, IV-B, and CAR got the highest accomplishment in terms of the percentage output that is more than 100% vis-à-vis the regions' target.
- Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (25.42%), Electrical and Electronics (14.86%), and Social, Community Development and Other Services (13.34%) sectors have the most number of certified individuals.
- The Chemical/Plastics/Petrochemicals, Creative, Decorative Crafts, Footwear and Leather-goods, Logistics, and Pyrotechnics sectors have no recorded output.
- A total of 42,814 were assessed and 40,822 were certified under the scholarship programs.
- Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant), and Metals and Engineering has the most number of assessed and certified based on the scholarship program outputs.
- Students, Farmers and Fishermen, and OSY obtained the highest number of beneficiaries in terms of number of assessed and certified.

PROGRAM REGISTRATION & TVET PROVIDERS; ASSESSMENT CENTERS & ASSESSORS; and TRAINERS

Program Registration

- As of December 2020, there is a total of 16,620 registered programs and 4,434 TVET Providers *(counted by establishment)*.
- Regions NCR (2,181, 13.12%), III (1,894, 11.40%), and IV-A (1,580, 9.51%) has the most number of registered programs and TVET providers.
- Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) has 4,189 registered program and 1,632 TVET providers *(counted by qualification)* which is the highest among the sectors.

- There is no registered program and TVET provider for these 5 sectors: Chemicals/Plastic; Decorative Crafts; Footwear and Leather-goods; Logistics; and Pyrotechnics.
- Out of the 4,434 TVET Providers, 4,001 are private type of provider and 433 are public. There are a total of 173 TESDA Technology Institutions that translates to a 39.95% of the overall number of public providers.

Assessors and Assessment Centers

- There is a total of 13,062 competency assessors and 7,341 assessment centers nationwide as of December 2020.
- Regions NCR, IV-A, and III are the top 3 regions with the greatest number of assessment centers and competency assessors.
- Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (1,921, 26.17% AC | 3,109, 23.80% Assessor), Construction (995, 13.55% AC | 1,513, 11.58% Assessor) , and Metals and Engineering (805, 10.97% AC | 1,489, 11.40% Assessor) recorded the highest number of assessment centers and competency assessors.
- Food and Beverage Services NC II (407, 5.54%), Bread and Pastry Production (340, 4.63%) NC II and Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW) NC II (330, 4.50%) have the highest number of assessment centers among all the qualifications.
- Most number of assessors are accounted on the following programs: Bread and Pastry Production NC II (735, 5.63%), Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW) NC II (708, 5.42%), and Electrical Installation and Maintenance NC II (596, 4.53%).

Trainers

- A total of 38,469 individuals are NTTC holders counted by qualification and 22,125 are counted as warm body.
- Regions NCR (5,942, 15.45%), III (3,716, 9.66%), and IV-A (3,634, 9.45%) have the most number of NTTC holders nationwide.
- Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (10,248, 26.64%), Electrical and Electronics (5,393, 14.02%), and Constructions (3,888, 10.11%) accounted the highest number of NTTC holders.
- Moreover, Computer Systems Servicing NC II (2,309, 6.00%), SMAW NC II (2,226, 5.79%) and Bread and Pastry Production NC II (2,083, 5.41%) recorded the most number NTTC holders.
- There is also 4,402 enrollees and 3,734 graduates of the Trainer's Methodology I (TM 1) with a completion rate of 85%.
- The Trainer's Methodology II has recorded a total of 1,355 enrollees and 289 graduates with only 21% completion rate.

GENDER-BASED OUTPUT

- The number of female enrollees and graduates is a slightly higher compared to male with percentage difference of 2% (18,972 for enrolled, 16,436 for graduates).
- In the assessed and certified, male recorded a slightly higher output than the female but both sex has the same certificate rate of 94%.
- Female enrollees and graduates dominated in NCR compared to the male output with 62% and 38% percentage distribution, respectively. While there is a higher number of male (238,631, 51.63%) certified individuals than female (223,558, 48.37%) recorded in NCR.
- While in BARMM, male dominated the number of enrollees, graduate, assessed and certified are accounted.
- The Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (80,022, 35.79%) sector recorded the highest number of female certified individuals.
- While Electrical and Electronics (47,840, 20.05%) sector have the highest number of male certified individuals.
- The number of assessed and certified females in Garments, Chemicals, and Processed Food & Beverage sector are significantly higher in terms of percentage distribution.
- However, Male enrollees and certified individuals dominated the Maritime, HVACR, Metals and Engineering, and constructions sector.
- Out of the 3,734 TM 1 graduates, 2,044 of which are female and 1,690 are male.

TRAINING REGULATIONS AND COMPETENCY STANDARDS

- A total of 21 Training Regulations were developed and 17 Training regulations were also reviewed.
- Eight (8) out of the 21 developed TR are under the Human Health / Health Care sector followed by 6 TRs from Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery.
- There are also 21 newly developed Competency Standards.
- Most of the new developed CS are under the Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery Sector.
- Its notable that TESDA has developed the Competency Standards for Contact Tracing Level II in support to the government's effort to mitigate the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic.

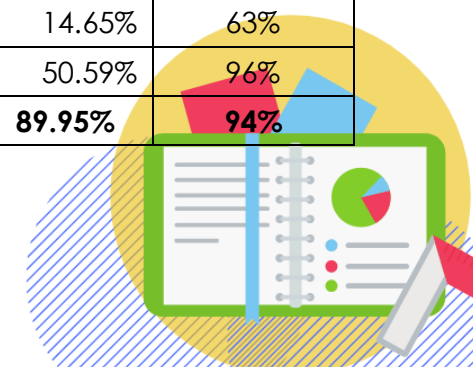
