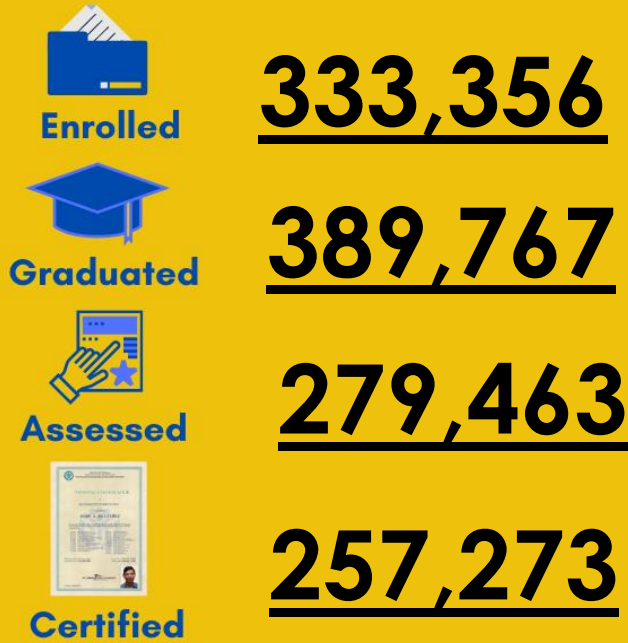

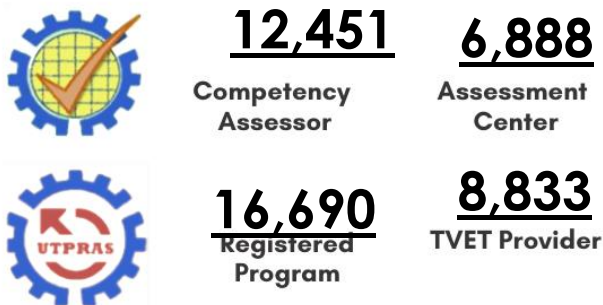

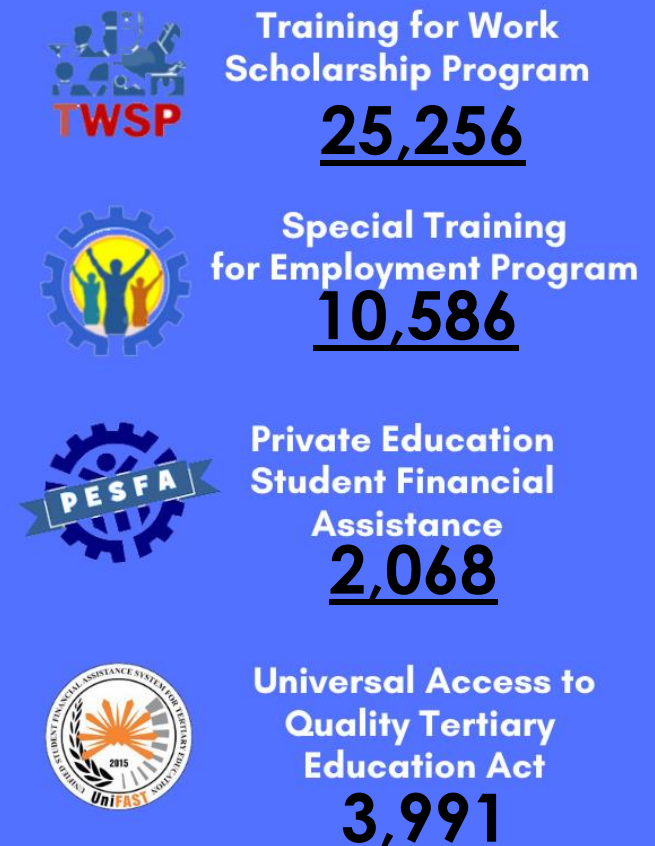

Table 1 shows the total number of enrolled and graduates as of June 2021. The enrollment and graduates recorded is below 50% output vis-à-vis its annual target for both enrollees and graduates which is 22.41% and 29.11%, respectively. Majority of TVET enrollees and graduates are female, with a slight difference is only 6.2% for enrolled and 1.8% for graduate. This low percentage accomplishment can be attributed to the restrictions due to the COVID-19 policies being implemented by the government.

For the 2nd quarter, there is a 21% increase in assessment and certification output against the 1st quarter report. However, the total output resulted to a decrease of 1.15% on the certification rate.

Among the 17 regions, TESDA region VI and VII got the highest percentage accomplishment of 74% on certified individuals against their regional target. While TESDA NCR has only 35% accomplishment of their target.

In terms of training venue, most of the enrollees and graduates are from the Institution Based Training with 165,580 (53%) enrollees and 225,635 (61%) graduates followed by Community-Based Training with 134,012 (43%) enrollees and 130,393 (35%) graduates, respectively. It is significant to note that the Enterprise-Based Training remains to have the lowest accounted number of enrollees which is only 9,990 or 3% of the total enrollees and 11,654 which covers 3% of the graduates. Table 3 also presents the monitored TVET training programs which are being implemented by different institutions/entities. The accounted enrollment is 23,774 and 22,175 graduates.



Compared to other delivery modes, institution-based is easier to implement in this time of pandemic provided that there is also an established guideline on the implementation of Flexible Training Delivery. For community-based, we can infer that majority of the LGU partners are now focused in immediately addressing the concerns in contact tracing and using their facilities as quarantine facilities, which may lessen their initiative towards conduct of skills training. On the other hand, for the enterprises, the current work arrangements being implemented contributes to the implementation of their training programs.

Table 4A shows the total number of enrollees by delivery mode, region and sex. For Institution based training, NCR has the highest number of enrollees (24,706) for Enterprise-based training, Region IV-A obtained the highest with 3,755 enrollees while Region II (17,780) and Region III (14,876). For Community-based, regions VIII (9,859) and IX (4,903) obtained the most number of enrollees. The number of registered programs in terms of training delivery influence the results of the outputs by delivery mode/training venue.

Similar to the results of the enrollment, Table 4B shows that the same regions obtained highest graduation outputs in terms of delivery mode/training venue. NCR has the highest number of graduates (26,335) for Enterprise-based training, Region III is the highest with 2,414 graduates while Region II (17,072) and Region VIII (16,348) recorded the highest number of graduates. For Monitored training programs, the top regions in terms of graduations are region VIII (8,952) and IX (4,715) respectively.

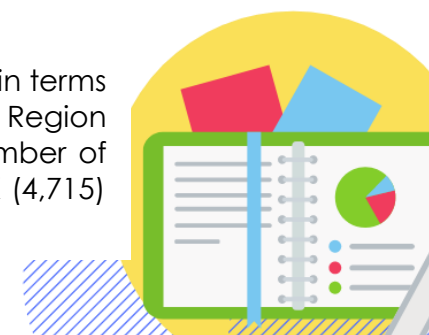
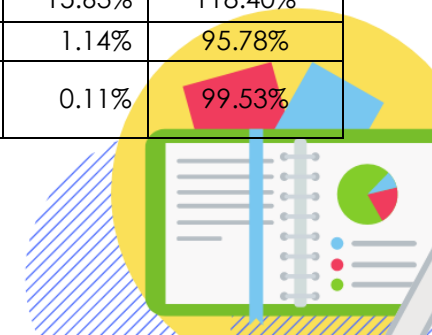

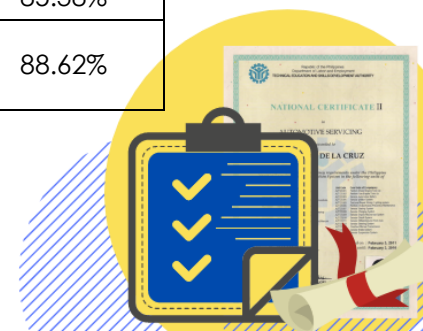

Still, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) has recorded the highest percentage share of 19% followed by Social, Community Development and Other Services with 15% and Automotive and Land Transportation sector with 13%. These public training providers have more output which can be attributed to the community-based training (CBT) that are implemented by the public providers, which covers the TTIs, LGUs, NGOs, and NGAs. This translates to 55% share of the number of enrollees (98,677 out of the total 177,879) is from CBT for public and 49% of this output is from TTI (48,824 out of the total 98,677 CBT enrollees). The CBT programs are usually short-term courses that are conducted in minimal duration

Table 9 shows the scholarship outputs under continuing appropriation of 2020. Among the scholarship programs, TWSP has the highest share in terms of enrollees, graduates, assessed and certified. This can be attributed to the budget allotted for the implementation of the programs. However, the Bayanihan 2 program accounted for the highest completion rate of 92.51%. The purposive implementation of programs under Bayanihan 2 in view of the pandemic highly contributes to the completion rate of the program.

The Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has recorded the highest number of scholarship beneficiaries in terms of enrolled (16,447) and graduates (11,660), assessed (5,334), and certified (5,066) beneficiaries overall. Similar to previous observations, the approval of budget allocation based on the submitted qualification maps of the ROPOs are factors that attributes to the sectoral outputs of the scholarship programs.

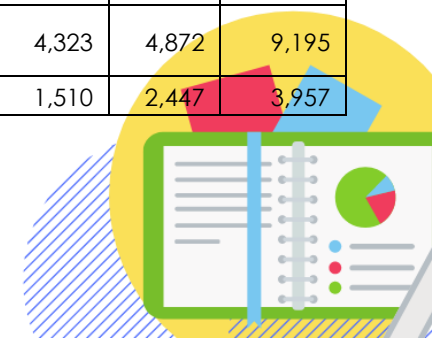

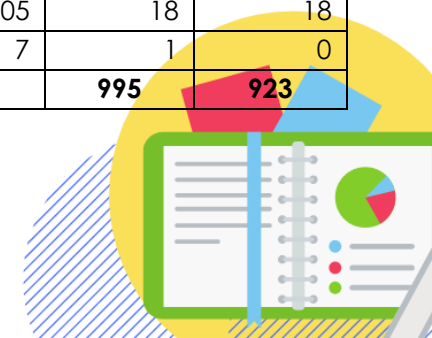

Tables 32 and 33 both illustrate the number of Partnerships Forged: by Region by Sector and by Sector, respectively. In terms of regional comparison, TESDA CAR has the greatest number of Partnerships Forged (67) compared to 45 of Region III (2nd highest), followed by Region IV-B with 36. As for region VI, it has the least number of partnerships forged for the 2nd quarter with only one. In terms of Sectoral Partnership, Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) tops the list with 61 partnerships forged, followed by Agriculture, Forestry and Fishery with 55. Among the sectors, Footwear and Leather Goods, Furniture and Fixtures, Logistics, Maritime, Pyrotechnics, and Visual Arts have no recorded number of partnerships forged.





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
