Table No. 1 shows the total number of enrolled and graduates as of September 2021. Accordingly, the calculated completion rate is 98%. Majority of TVET enrollees and graduates are female, with a difference of 36,568 for enrolled and 25,685 for graduates, respectively. It is also evident that the number of graduates is relatively lower than the number of enrolled.

For the 3rd quarter, there is a 25% increase in both assessment and certification as compared to the 2nd quarter report. However, there is a 1.41% decrease on the certification rate.

Among the 17 regions, TESDA Region VII and CAR has achieved more than 100% of their target certified individuals. While TESDA Region V and NCR are still below 60% of their target output.

In terms of training venue, most of the enrollees and graduates are from the Institution Based Training with 306,920 (46%) enrollees and 324,097 (49%) graduates; followed by Community-Based Training with 263,663 (39%) enrollees and 243,385 (37%) graduates, respectively.

It is significant to note that the Enterprise-Based Training remains to have the lowest accounted number of enrollees which is only 46,703 or 7% of the total enrollees and 44,419 which covers 7% of the graduates.

This table also presents the monitored TVET training programs which are being implemented by different institutions/entities. The total number of enrolled is 53,996 and 46,096 graduates.



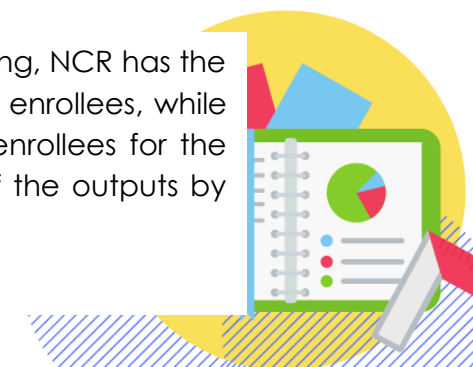

Table No. 4A shows the total number of enrollees by delivery mode, region and sex. For Institution based training, NCR has the highest number of enrollees (42,696). For Enterprise-based training, Region X obtained the highest with 8,347 enrollees, while Region III has 42,758 enrollees for the Community-based, and Region VIII, on the other hand, has 20,596 enrollees for the monitored program. The number of registered programs in terms of training delivery influence the results of the outputs by delivery mode/training venue.



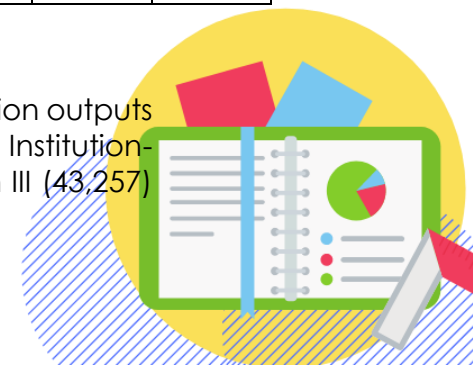

Similar to the results of the enrollment, table 4B shows that the same regions have obtained the highest graduation outputs in terms of delivery mode/training venue. Accordingly, NCR has the highest number of graduates (41,790) for Institution-based training, For Enterprise-based training, Region X obtained the highest with 6,672 enrollees, while Region III (43,257) for the Community-based, and Region VIII (15,868) for the monitored program.



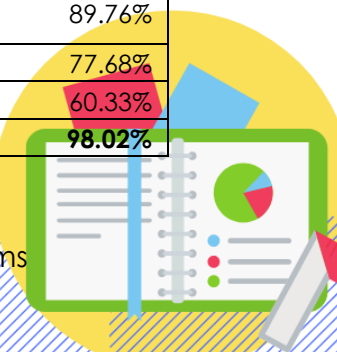

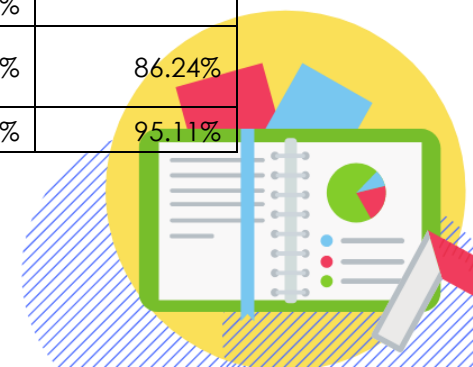

Table 9 shows the scholarship outputs under continuing appropriation of 2020. Among the scholarship programs, TWSP has the highest share in terms of enrollees and graduates with a total of 49,582 and 38,566, respectively. On the other hand, UAQTEA topped the number of assessed and certified with a sum of 29,602 and 27,906, respectively. This can be attributed to the budget allotted for the implementation of the programs.

The Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has recorded the highest number of scholarship beneficiaries in terms of enrolled (28,736) and graduates (22,685), assessed (12,548), and certified (11,916) beneficiaries overall. 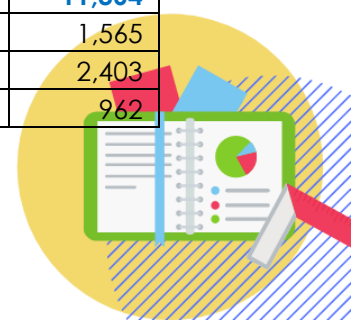

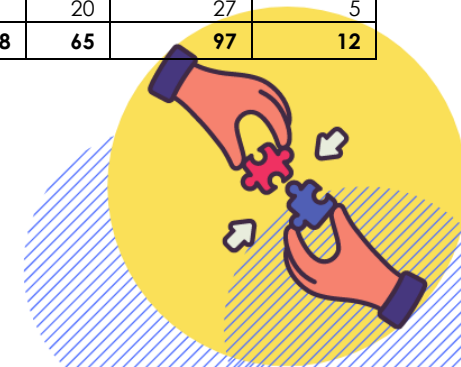

Tables 32 and 33 both illustrate the number of Partnerships Forged: by Region by Sector and by Sector, respectively.

In terms of regional comparison, TESDA CARAGA has the greatest number of Partnerships Forged (97) compared to 65 of CAR (2<sup>nd</sup> highest), followed by Region III with 48.
