Majority of TVET enrollees and graduates are female, with a percentage difference of 11.90% for enrolled and 3.46% for graduates, respectively. Among the scholarship programs, TWSP has the highest EGAC output with a percent distribution of 51.34% - Enrolled, 65.77% - Graduates, 72.02% - Assessed, and 74.04% - Certified. It was followed by the scholarship programs under the RESP (15.88% - Enrolled | 2.55% - Graduated) and UAQTEA (11.07% - Enrolled | 3.44% - Graduated). However, both RESP and UAQTEA do not have outputs for assessed and certified. This can be attributed to the budget allotted for the implementation of the programs.

For the FY 2021 continuing appropriation, the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector has recorded the highest number of scholarship beneficiaries in terms of enrolled (18.60%), graduates (18.33%), assessed (20.98%), and certified (21.90%) beneficiaries overall, followed by the construction sector - enrolled (17.13%), graduates (17.71%), assessed (18.79%), and certified (18.76%). The approval of budget allocation based on the submitted qualification maps of the ROPOs are factors that contribute to the sectoral outputs of the scholarship programs.

As of 2nd Quarter 2022, there are two (2) on-going developments under Competency Standards (CS) namely Data Processing and Management (Program Registration & Training) Level II and Data Processing and Management (Competency Assessment & Certification) Level II, both under the TVET sector. Accordingly, four (4) Training Regulations (TR) are on-going developments, which are Trainer's Methodology III and IV both under the TVET sector; and Cyber Threat Monitoring NC I and Cyber Threat Mitigation NC II both under the Information and Communication Technology sector. For TRs in subject for on-going review, there are four (4) qualifications under the Information and Communication Technology sector, which are Gaming Programming NC III, 3D Game Arts NC III, 3D Game Animation NC III, 2D Game Arts NC III, and 2D Game Animation NC III that are being evaluated.

In the same quarter of 2022, six (6) Competency Standards (CS) were developed which are Butterfly Production Level II, under the Agriculture, Fishery, and Forestry sector; SCADA Operations Level II, SCADA Programming Level III, SCADA Integration Level III, all under the Electronics sector; and, Data Encoding and Management Level II, under the Information and Communications Technology. Following this, the Training Regulation (TR) of the Landscape Maintenance and Installation NC II under the Agriculture, Fishery, and Forestry sector has been completely reviewed.
