For the FY 2021 continuing appropriation, the Construction sector has recorded the overall highest number of scholarship beneficiaries in terms of enrollees (18.14%), graduates (18.14%), assessed (20.80%), and certified (21.15%), followed by the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector - enrollees (18.12%), graduates (18.08%), assessed (20.20%), and certified (21.09%). The target beneficiaries, type of scholarships, and the approval of budget allocation based on the submitted qualification maps of the ROPOs are the factors that contribute to the sectoral outputs of the scholarship programs.

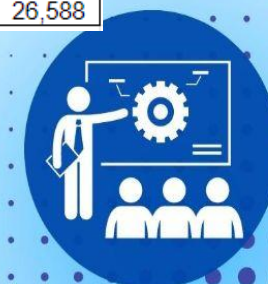
