**PRIORITIZATION OF ADDITIONAL FOUR (4) QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR YEAR 2005 (MASONRY NCI, JEWELRY MAKING NCII, FISH CAPTURE NCII AND AGRI-CROPS PRODUCTION NCII)**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14 item (b) of RA 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and to conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

**WHEREAS**, during the 8<sup>th</sup> Standard Setting and Systems Development TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 29 March 2005 and 12 May 2005 respectively the body recommended to focus its efforts and resources on priority qualifications identified with partner industry bodies and associations on the basis of :

1. Priority needs of the industry sector
2. Nationwide application in terms of public interest/welfare
3. The criteria for skills standardization and certification
  - Requires education or training
  - Performance of the competency affects and endangers people's lives and limbs
  - Competency involves the handling of complex equipment, tools and supplies
  - Competency affects consumers interest
4. Employment generation and investment opportunities

**WHEREAS**, in the 43<sup>rd</sup> Executive Committee –TESDA Board Meeting held on 14 July 2005 the EXCOM-TESDA Board endorsed favorably the inclusion of **Masonry, Fish Capture NCII and Agri-Crops Production NCII** as additional priority qualifications;

**WHEREAS**, in the 11<sup>th</sup> Standard Setting and Systems Development TESDA Board- TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 18 July 2005 the body recommended the inclusion of **jewelry making** as priority qualification;

**WHEREAS**, in the above mentioned meetings the members of the TESDA Board endorsed favorably the prioritization of the four (4) additional qualifications;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Board approve and give high priority to the following four (4) additional qualifications under the Philippine TVET Qualifications Framework (PTQF) and hereby direct the TESDA Secretariat to undertake the development of training regulations for said qualifications :

**Construction**

1. Masonry NCI

**Decorative Crafts**

2. Jewelry Making NCII

**Agri- Fisheries**

3. Fish Capture NCII ( Municipal Fishing)
4. Agri-Crops Production NCII ( Independent Farming)


