**APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF THE PROVISIONAL TRAINING FEES OF TESDA TRAINING CENTER TAGUIG CAMPUS ENTERPRISE (CO-MANAGEMENT SCHEME) FOR ONE YEAR (JANUARY TO DECEMBER 2006) SUBJECT TO REVIEW AFTER SIX MONTHS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 8, paragraph 9 of Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994", empowers the TESDA Board to "exact reasonable fees and charges for such tests and training conducted, and retain such earnings for its own use subject to guidelines promulgated by the Authority";

**WHEREAS**, Board Resolution No. 2004-07 "Approving the Policy on Progressive Devolution" paragraph 5 provides a four (4) stage progressive devolution program with a twenty five (25) year horizon namely: Stage 1 – Decentralization Stage - Started Implementation of Preparatory Phase 1 (2001-2003) and Partnership Building Phase 2 (2004-2009), Stage 2 – **Programmed Devolution Stage – Co-Management Phase 1 (2010-2015) and Co-Management Phase 2 (2016-2021)**, Stage 3 – Stabilization Stage (2022-2027), and Stage 4 – Evaluation Stage (2028-2030);

**WHEREAS**, Board Resolution No. 2005-17 "Approving The Provisional Training Fees of TESDA Training Center Taguig Campus Enterprise (Co-Management Scheme)" paragraphs 4 and 7 states that the "provisional exaction of fees will be implemented to selected trade areas with experimentation period of two (2) months from November to December 2005" and "the TESDA Secretariat, to evaluate the result of the two (2) months pilot phase, and to submit its findings and recommendations to the TESDA Board not later than January 13, 2006, which shall decide whether the Co-Management Scheme training fees as proposed shall be continued or revised in 2006;"

**WHEREAS**, during the 13<sup>th</sup> Finance-TESDA Board and TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 26 January 2006, it was noted that the 2-month experimentation period cannot generate substantial information to serve as basis for evaluation, hence, the recommendation of the TESDA Secretariat for an extension of said provisional training fees for twelve (12) months from January to December 2006 subject to review after six months, was favorably endorsed;

**WHEREAS**, in the Special TESDA Board Meeting held 31 January 2006, the TESDA Board considered and approved the recommendation made by the TESDA Board Members during the 13<sup>th</sup> Finance TESDA Board – TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting, 26 January 2006;




**BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY**, that copy of the resolution shall be disseminated to all concerned.
