WHEREAS, Section 14 item (b) of RA 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and to conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, during 17th Standard Setting and Systems Development TESDA Board- TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting, 26 September 2006 the body recommended to focus its efforts and resources on priority qualifications identified with partner industry bodies and associations on the basis of :

1. Priority needs of the industry sector
2. Nationwide application in terms of public interest/welfare
3. Employment generation and investment opportunities
4. The criteria for skills standardization and certification
 - o Requires education or training
 - o Performance of the competency affects and endangers people's lives and limbs
 - o Competency involves the handling of complex equipment, tools and supplies
 - o Competency affects consumers interest


