WHEREAS, Section 14 item (b) of RA 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and to conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2006-03 on the Prioritization of the sixty two (62) Qualifications for the Development of Training Regulations For Year 2006 was approved during the Special TESDA Board Meeting held on 31 January 2006;

WHEREAS, the Qualification and Standards Office submitted to the Chair of the Standard Setting and Systems Development Committee on the needed corrections to TESDA Board Resolution No. 2006-03 Prioritization of the sixty two (62) Qualifications for the Development of Training Regulations for Year 2006;

WHEREAS, during the 46th Executive Committee- TESDA Board Meeting held on 19 October 2006, the members of the EXCOM- TESDA Board approved and expressed conformity with the amendments on Board Resolution No. 2006-03 on the prioritization of the sixty two (62) qualifications for the development of training regulations for year 2006 on the nomenclature and sectoral classification specifically

Changes in Nomenclature under the Agri- Fishery Sector (Agricultural Crops)

1. The nomenclature of Independent Farming- Agronomy NCII should be changed to ***Agricultural Crop Production NCIII*** because the qualification pertains to an independent farmer, not a tenant or farm worker, who tills and manages the small farm land on his own and the qualifications entails some decision making and technical judgement regarding integrated and sustainable farming;
2. The nomenclature of Independent Farming-Horticulture – Screed should be ***Horticulture NCIII*** and the entry “Screed” under the column on PTQF level, page 1 of the resolution, should be transferred to Construction Sector and renamed as Heavy Equipment Operation (Concreting and Asphaltting-Screed (Paver) NCI:

Changes in Nomenclature under the Agri- Fishery Sector

3. The nomenclature of Fishing Gear Design/Maintenance should be changed to ***Fishing Gear Repair /Maintenance*** because the TVET qualifications should focus only on repair/maintenance and not on designing,
4. The nomenclature of Disease Control should be changed to ***Disease and Pest Control (Vegetables)*** because disease and pest control should always go hand in hand;
5. The nomenclature of Pest Control should be changed to ***Disease and Pest Control (Animals)*** because disease and pest control should always go hand in hand;

Changes in Sectoral Classification

1. The Slaughtering under Agri-Fishery Sector as priority qualification was reclassified under **Processed Food and Beverages Sector- Slaughtering Operation NCII** because slaughtering operation is the first step in meat processing procedure;
2. The entry "SCREED" under the column on PTQF level, agri-fishery sector Agricultural Crops (**Independent Farming Horticulture**) **Screed**, page 1 of the resolution, should be transferred to Construction Sector and renamed as **Heavy Equipment Operation (Concreting and Asphaltting-Screed (Paver) NCI**;




