APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE AMENDMENTS ON THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR SECURITY SERVICES NCII

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2004-20 "Approving and Adopting the Training Regulations for Security Services NCII" was promulgated by the TESDA Board during the 44th TESDA Board Meeting which was held last 9 December 2004;

WHEREAS, part of the competency requirements for Security Services NCII is now covered in Security Services NCI which serves as an entry requirement to Security Services NCII;

WHEREAS, under current Philippine National Police (PNP) guidelines, prospective security guards must complete the pre-licensing course covered in Security Services NCI before moving on to Security Services NCII;

WHEREAS, a person who has achieved this Security Services NCII is competent to be Security Guard and a Watchman;

WHEREAS, during the 2nd Joint Standard Setting and Systems Development and Finance TESDA Board- TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting, 12 February 2007, the members of the Standard Setting and Systems Development and Finance Committee- TESDA Board favorably endorsed for consideration and approval of the Board the revision of Section 1 paragraph 3 and the nominal training duration covered under the curriculum design of Section 3 of the Training Regulations for Security Services NCII as follows:
