APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR
COMMERCIAL COOKING (COOKERY) NCIII, COMMERCIAL COOKING (COOKERY) NCIV, FOOD AND
BEVERAGE SERVICE NCIII, FOOD AND BEVERAGE SERVICE NCIV

WHEREAS, the concerned industry Working Group (Tourism Board Foundation, Incorporated) has endorsed for promulgation the aforementioned Training Regulations;

WHEREAS, during the 3rd Joint Standard Setting and Systems Development and Finance TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation, and 22nd Standard Setting and Systems Development TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting last 13 March 2007 and 18 April 2007 respectively, the following training regulations were deliberated and favorably recommended to the TESDA Board for approval:

Tourism Sector


1. Commercial Cooking (Cookery) NCIII
2. Commercial Cooking (Cookery) NCIV
3. Food and Beverage Service NCIII
4. Food and Beverage Service NCIV

WHEREAS, in the 55th TESDA Board Meeting held on 20 April 2007, the TESDA Board considered and approved the Training Regulations for Commercial Cooking (Cookery) NCIII, and Commercial Cooking (Cookery) NCIV; Food and Beverage Service NCIII, Food and Beverage Service NCIV;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board promulgates the aforementioned Training Regulations;

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that copies of the resolution and training regulations be published and disseminated to all concerned, and shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon its publication. All programs registered under or to be under these training regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned training regulations. Graduates of TVET courses covered by the aforementioned training regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification system.
