**APPROVING THE DECREASE OF ASSESSMENT FEES AND AMENDING THEREOF ALL PREVIOUS BOARD RESOLUTIONS ON ASSESSMENT FEES ACCORDINGLY**

**WHEREAS**, Section 8, paragraph 9 of Republic Act No. 7796 or the Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994 empowers the TESDA Board to "exact reasonable fees and charges for such tests and training conducted and retain such earnings for its own use, subject to guidelines promulgated by the Authority;"

**WHEREAS**, in the 54<sup>th</sup> TESDA Board Meeting held 16 January 2007 the TESDA Board approved **Board Resolution No. 2007-02** "Approving the Extension of Provisional Assessment Fees on Forty Five (45) Qualifications Based on the Previously Approved Board Resolution No. 2005-18 for period of six (6) months subject to review" and **Board Resolution No. 2007-03** "Approving the Exaction of Uniform Assessment Fee of One Thousand Pesos (PhP1,000.00) for the remaining sixty-three (63) qualifications for a period of six (6) months subject to review", and **Board Resolution No. 2007-08** "Approving the Amendments on the Provisional Assessment Fee Household Services NC II" approved by referendum during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Joint Standard Setting and Systems Development and Finance TESDA Board – TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held on 12 February 2007;

**WHEREAS**, during the 21<sup>st</sup> Finance TESDA Board – TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held on 16 April 2007 the Finance Committee - TESDA Board favorably endorsed for consideration and approval of the Board the decrease of assessment fees and amending thereof all previous board resolutions on assessment fees accordingly based on the recommendations of the TESDA Secretariat after presentations of the following justifications:

The proposal for the amendment of the previously deployed assessment fees were due to the **reactions from the field such as:**

- Deployed fees are too high for parents to shoulder;
- The fees are not affordable, even to workers; and
- Lower fees can assist in the advocacy of the assessment and certification program.

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PREVIOUS BOARD RESOLUTIONS ON ASSESSMENT FEES ACCORDINGLY**

**Considerations in the formulation of the provisional Assessment Fees**

- The ratio of assessor to candidate is 1:1
- Cost of supplies and materials was computed on a per qualification basis
- Most of the assessors consulted were from the private sector (e.g. Caregiving, Household Services)
- Test Project to be performed by the candidate is based on the recommended activities in the assessment tool

**Bases for the proposed amendment of assessment fees**

- Group assessment (4-5 per batch) can be undertaken, when applicable
- Cost of assessment is based on specific test project identified in the assessment tool

**The Secretariat conducted a study on the provisional assessment fees involving two (2) Processes:**

**Process 1 - Desk review by focal person with technical experts**

**Process 2 - On site consultation with trainers, competency assessor and assessment center administrators**


