WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2004-20 "Approving and Adopting the Training Regulations for **Heavy-equipment Operation NCII**, Driving NCII, Automotive Body painting/Finishing NCII, Welding NCII, Footwear Making NCII, Security Service NCII, and Animal Production NCII was approved and adopted by the TESDA Board during its 44th TESDA Board Meeting held last 9 December 2004;

WHEREAS, the experience in the field after the promulgation of such Training Regulation has been that developments in technology has led to workers needing to acquire and upgrade their proficiency in the operation of only one heavy equipment for them to be considered competent and be fully employed as heavy- equipment operator;

WHEREAS, the Association of Carriers and Equipment Lessors, Inc. (ACEL), the body representing the heavy equipment sub-sector of the construction industry, in its letter to the Board dated 14 June 2007 has pointed out the situation in their sub-sector where their heavy equipment operators tend to specialize and acquire expertise in only one heavy-equipment and then be productively and fully employed and recognized as expert in their field and thus recommended to the Committee a repackaging rule to allow for NCII level for each Heavy-Equipment;

WHEREAS, in the 23rd Standard Setting and Systems Development-TESDA Board- TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last June 26, 2007 the Technical Expert Panel (Association of Carriers & Equipment Lessors, Inc.) has endorsed for consideration the following Qualification in lieu of Heavy Equipment Operation NCII;

WHEREAS, during the 24th Standard Setting and Systems Development-TESDA Board TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting on 16 July 2007 discussed the subject matter and finally decided to recommend to the eXCOM-TESDA Board to allow for NCII level certification for each Heavy-Equipment;

WHEREAS, during the 50th EXCOM-TESDA Board Meeting held on 17 July 2007 the aforementioned qualifications was endorsed favorably for consideration of the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, during the 56th TESDA Board meeting held on 27 July 2007 the TESDA Board members considered and approved the amendments of the packaging rule for qualification in Heavy Equipment Operation and promulgation of training regulations as a separate qualification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board shall revise the packaging rule in the qualifications for Heavy Equipment Operation to require candidates to demonstrate competency in only one (1) heavy equipment for them to be awarded the qualification and hereby directs the Secretariat to implement this amendment to the previously approved certificate of competencies (COCs) in Heavy-Equipment Operation as well as for the new qualifications in Heavy-Equipment Operation to be presented to the Board for approval:

- Heavy Equipment Operation on Wheel Loader NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Motor Grader NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Hydraulic Excavation NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Bulldozer NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Forklift NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Tower Crane NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Crawler Crane NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Truck Mounted Crane NCII
- Heavy Equipment Operation on Rough Terrain Crane NCII



All programs registered under the training regulation must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned training regulation. Graduates of TVET courses covered by the aforementioned training regulation shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification.
