**APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATION FOR
FISHPORT/WHARF OPERATIONS NCI**

WHEREAS, Section 14 item (b) of RA 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and to conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, in the 55th TESDA Board Meeting which was held last 20 April 2007, the TESDA Board considered and approved Board Resolution No. 2007-11 on the prioritization of fifty three (53) titles for training regulations development for year 2007 where Fishport/Wharf Operations NCI under the agriculture and fisheries sector was included;

WHEREAS, the concerned Industry Working Group (Philippine Chamber of Agriculture and Foods, Inc.) has endorsed for promulgation the aforementioned Training Regulation for Fishport/wharf Operations NCI;

WHEREAS, in the 23rd Standard Setting and Systems Development-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 26 June 2007, the aforementioned Training Regulation was deliberated upon and it was suggested to further review the competency map of the Fishport/Wharf Operations NCI because it includes competencies along Construction and Shipbuilding such as dry docking operations, carpentry works, motor pool operations and logistic operations;

WHEREAS, in the 25th Standard Setting and Systems Development-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held last 05 September, 2007 the competencies of unload and load fish products, and classify fish and fish products in the competency map for Fish Capture Operation of the aforementioned Training Regulation;

WHEREAS, in the 52nd EXCOM-TESDA Board Meeting held on 30 October, 2007, the EXCOM-TESDA Board endorsed favorably the aforementioned training regulation for consideration and approval of the TESDA Board;

FISHPORT/WHARF OPERATIONS NCI**


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,

Regulations (TRs) be published and disseminated to all concerned and shall be
effective fifteen (15) days upon its publication. All programs registered under or to
be under these training regulations must comply with the requirements of the
aforementioned training regulations. Graduates of TVET courses covered by the
aforementioned training regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory
assessment under the national assessment and certification system.
