APPROVING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT TO V. G. ROXAS COMPANY, INC. AMOUNTING TO Php113,033,072.03 AS THE BIDDER WITH THE LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION AND COMMISSIONING OF VARIOUS TESTING AND TRAINING TOOLS/EQUIPMENT UNDER LEPTES-02

WHEREAS, Section 8, paragraph 3 of Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994" grants the TESDA Board the power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry out domestic and foreign contracts subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts both local and foreign entered into by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) as mandated by Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" is the body tasked to post invitation to bid, conduct pre-bid conferences, determine the eligibility of prospective bidders, receive and open bids, conduct the evaluation of bids, undertake post-qualification proceedings, and recommend award of contracts to the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), through Republic Act No. 9336, or the General Appropriations Act of FY2006 as re-enacted, intends to apply the amount of Php116,030,209.44 being the Approved Budget for Contract (ABC) to payment for the supply, delivery, installation, and Commissioning of various training and testing tools and equipment for the implementation of the Ladderized Education Program (LEP) under LEPTES-02;

WHEREAS, the BAC, in exercising its functions and in accordance with procedures pursuant to RA No. 9184 has recommended through BAC Resolution No.062-2007 the award of contract to **V.G. ROXAS COMPANY, INC.** for the supply and delivery of various LEP training and testing tools/equipment as the bidder having the lowest calculated and responsive bid for six (6) lots with a total bid of **Php113,033,072.03**;

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WHEREAS, the following documents have been appended which shall form as an integral part of this Resolution:

WHEREAS, during the 26th Finance TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting last 19 October, 2007 the TESDA Secretariat through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) recommended for approval the award of contract to **V.G. ROXAS COMPANY, INC.** amounting to **Php113,033,072.03** as the bidder with the lowest calculated and responsive bids for the supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of various testing and training tools/equipment under LEPTES-02, subject however to a condition that the awarded bidder should be one hundred percent (100%) technically and financially compliant;

WHEREAS, in the 52nd EXCOM-TESDA Board Meeting held 30 October, 2007 the members of the TESDA Board favorably endorsed on the basis of the recommendation made by the members of the TESDA Board present during the 26th Finance TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting last 19 October, 2007 the award of contract to **V.G. ROXAS COMPANY, INC.** amounting to **Php113,033,072.03** as the bidder with the lowest calculated and responsive bids for the supply, delivery, installation and commissioning of various testing and training tools/equipment under LEPTES-02;

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


