### DELISTING PC OPERATIONS NCII AS A PROMULGATED TRAINING REGULATION

WHEREAS, Board Resolution No. 2005-19 "Approving and Promulgating the Training Regulation for PC Operations NCII" was approved and promulgated by the TESDA Board during the 48<sup>th</sup> TESDA Board Meeting held last 10 November 2005;

WHEREAS, during the 31<sup>st</sup> Standard Setting and Systems Development-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held on 04 April 2008, the Committee recommended delisting the PC Operations NCII as a separate qualification. Instead, specific units of competency (Word Processing, Spreadsheets, Power Point Presentation and Internet) will be embedded as common competencies in relevant qualifications as the Recognized National Industry Body/Industry Associations/Experts will see fit.

WHEREAS, during the aforementioned Committee Meeting, it was agreed upon by the body that such delisting will be done within a transition period of one (1) year;

WHEREAS, during the 32<sup>nd</sup> Standard Setting and Systems Development TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting held on 13 May 2008, the delisting of said Training Regulation was favorably recommended to the EXCOMTESDA Board for consideration and approval of the TESDA Board;

WHEREAS, in the 57<sup>th</sup> EXCOM-TESDA Board Meeting held on 21 May 2008; 1:00 p.m. the EXCOM-TESDA Board endorsed favorably the delisting of the approved Training Regulation for PC Operations NCII.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 21 May 2008; 2:30 p.m. approves the delisting of PC Operations NCII as a national qualification and the incorporation of its core competencies in the common competencies of other relevant national qualifications as will be recommended by the concerned industry bodies/experts.

## DELISTING PC OPERATIONS NCII AS A PROMULGATED TRAINING REGULATION

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY that copies of this resolution be published and disseminated to all concerned and shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon its publication. All TVET providers with registered PC Operations NCII program shall be given one (1) year from effectivity of this resolution to phase out such programs. Competency Assessment and Certification for PC Operations NCII shall likewise be phased-out with one (1) year from effectivity of this resolution. Guidelines for this transition shall be issued by the Secretariat within 60 days from effectivity of this resolution.
