APPROVING THE AWARD OF CONTRACTS TO STATE ALLIANCE ENTERPRISES, INC. AMOUNTING TO Php46,054,480.91, XIAMEN HUAMIN IMPORT & EXPORT CO. LTD. AMOUNTING TO Php76,942,084.23 AND V.G. ROXAS COMPANY, INC. AMOUNTING TO Php18,387,813.58 FOR THE SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, TESTING, TRAINING AND COMMISSIONING OF VARIOUS CIVIL TECHNOLOGY TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT UNDER ADBTES-07

WHEREAS, Section 8, paragraph 3 of Republic Act No. 7796 otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994" grants the TESDA Board the power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry out domestic and foreign contracts subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts both local and foreign entered into by the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) as mandated by Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act" is the body tasked to post invitation to bid, conduct pre-bid conferences, determine the eligibility of prospective bidders, receive and open bids, conduct the evaluation of bids, undertake post-qualification proceedings, and recommend award of contracts to the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS The Republic of the Philippines has received a loan from the Asian Development Bank (ADB) towards the cost of the Technical Education and Skills Development Project (TESDP), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments under the contracts for the Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing, Training and Commissioning of various Civil Technology Tools and Equipment;

WHEREAS, during the submission of bids and bid opening, only three (3) bidders submitted their bids and passed the preliminary examination of bids and found them to be substantially compliant, to wit:
