WHEREAS, Section 8 of Republic Act No. 7796, otherwise known as the "Technical Education and Skills Development Act of 1994," grants the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) Board the power to enter into, make, execute, perform and carry out domestic and foreign contracts subject to existing law, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, in the exercise of this power, the TESDA Board shall approve all contracts entered into by the TESDA;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) as mandated by Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, is the body tasked to post invitation to bid, conduct pre-bid conferences, determine the eligibility of prospective bidders, receive and open bids, conduct the evaluation of bids, undertake post-qualification proceedings and recommend award of contracts to the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) requested from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) the realignment of the Twenty Million (Php20,000,000.00) allotment for Buildings and Structures Outlay and Office Equipment, Furniture and Fixtures under FY 2012 General Appropriations Act (GAA) (Republic Act No. 10155) for the acquisition of twenty (20) units of motor vehicles with the Terms of Reference (TOR) duly approved by the Director General justifying the realignment;

WHEREAS, as a result of such request, the DBM issued Special Allotment Release Order (SARO) No. B-12-0013722 on 13 July 2012 amounting to Twenty Million Pesos Only (Php 20,000,000.00) for the acquisition of twenty (20) units of motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, the TESDA intends to apply the sum of Twenty Million Pesos Only (Php 20,000,000.00) being the total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) for the procurement of TESDA service vehicles per TOR duly approved by the Director General.

WHEREAS, the BAC upon receipt of the Terms of Reference (TOR) with the corresponding SARO No. No. B-12-0013722 convened on 26 July 2012 to conduct a pre-procurement conference with the end-user's representative in accordance with Section 20 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184;

WHEREAS, as a result of the pre-procurement conference held on 26 July 2012, the BAC issued a memorandum to the Director IV, OCSA dated 27 July 2012 indicating the observations of the BAC, particularly on the prescription of technical specifications in connection with the TOR for the procurement of TESDA service vehicles. As such, the TOR was referred back to the end-user to consider the observations of the BAC;

WHEREAS, on 01 August 2012, the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) approved the TESDA's request for authority to purchase twenty (20) units of motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, on 08 August 2012, the Director IV of OCSA issued a memorandum submitting to the BAC the technical specifications of the TESDA vehicles to be procured by TESDA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 21 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, TESDA advertised on 14 August 2012 the Invitation to Bid for the procurement of TESDA service vehicles in a newspaper of general circulation and posted the same in the PhilGEPS;

WHEREAS, on 14 August 2012, another pre-procurement conference was held to deliberate on the requirements for bidding and bid evaluation;

WHEREAS, responding to the abovementioned Invitation to Bid, only Toyota Commonwealth Incorporated signified its interest to participate in said bidding process by purchasing bidding documents:

WHEREAS, the Technical Working Group (TWG), created by the BAC through its Order No. 03 on 29 August 2012, in its report found the bid offered by Toyota Commonwealth Incorporated to be compliant with the legal, technical and financial requirements set forth by the agency pursuant to Section 34 of Rule X (Post-qualification) of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184:
