
Section 2-Competency Standards (Training Regulation for Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning)
WHEREAS, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, TESDA Board Resolution No. 2004-21 entitled "Authorizing the Publication of the Reformatted Training Regulations for Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning (RAC) Servicing NC II" was issued on 09 May 2004 during the 44th TESDA Board Meeting;

WHEREAS, in the 52nd Standards Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting on 12 July 2012 at 10:00 a.m., certain revisions on the Core Competencies in the Training Regulations for Refrigeration and Air-Conditioning (RAC) Servicing NC II were deliberated upon by the Technical Expert Committee from the Maintenance Association of the Philippines/Philippine Society of Ventilation, Air-Conditioning and Refrigeration and Engineers (MAPHIL/PSAVARE) and the same were favorably recommended to the TESDA Board for consideration and approval, to wit:

WHEREAS, in the 83rd TESDA Board Meeting on 17 September 2012 at 2:00 p.m., the TESDA Board considered and approved the above amendments to the aforementioned Training Regulation;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 17 September 2012 at 2:00 p.m., approves the amendments to the aforementioned Training Regulations;

BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY, that copies of this Resolution and the abovementioned Training Regulations be published and disseminated to all concerned, and the same shall be effective fifteen (15) days upon publication. All programs registered under these Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
