

**PRIORITIZATION OF THE QUALIFICATION TITLES OF AND APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC I, SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC II AND SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC III**

**WHEREAS**, Item (B), Section 14 of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

**WHEREAS**, in the 50<sup>th</sup> Standards Setting and Systems Development (SSSD)-Committee-TESDA-Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting on 15 December 2011 at 9:30 a.m., the body recommended to focus the efforts and resources of the agency on priority qualifications identified by partner-industry bodies and association on the basis of:

1. Priority needs of the industry sector;
2. Nationwide application in terms of public interest/welfare;
3. Employment generation and investment opportunities; and
4. The criteria for skills standardization and certification, to wit:
  - Requiring relatively long education and training;
  - Performance of the competency affects and endangers people's lives and limbs; and
  - Competency involves the handling of complex equipment, tools and suppliers.

**PRIORITIZATION OF THE QUALIFICATION TITLES OF AND APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC I, SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC II AND SHIP'S CATERING SERVICES NC III**


**WHEREAS**, in the aforementioned meeting, the industry experts and partners recommended the Ship's Catering Services NC I, Ship's Catering Services NC II and Ship's Catering Services NC III as priority qualification titles based on the abovementioned criteria;

**WHEREAS**, in view of the coming into force of the Maritime Labor Conventions 2006 on 20 August 2013, which has been ratified by the Philippine Government on 20 August 2012, it is urgent to comply with the requirements of the ratified convention;

**WHEREAS**, in the 56<sup>th</sup> Standards Setting and Systems Development (SSSD) Committee-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting on 09 May 2013 the body discussed the proposed training regulations and agreed to recommend for approval of the TESDA Board the prioritization, adoption and promulgation of the aforementioned Training Regulations for Ship's Catering Services NC I, Ship's Catering Services NC II and Ship's Catering Services NC III provided that the Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) and Assessment Tools of the aforesaid training regulations shall have been validated before their publication;

**WHEREAS**, in the 85<sup>th</sup> TESDA Board Meeting on 17 May 2013 at 2:30 p.m., upon recommendation of the 56<sup>th</sup> Standards Setting and Systems Development (SSSDC) Committee-TESDA Board-TESDA Secretariat Consultation Meeting, 09 May 2013, the TESDA Board considered and approved the prioritization of the three (3) aforementioned qualification titles for training regulations development and approved the Training Regulations for Ship's Catering Services NC I, Ship's Catering Services NC II and Ship's Catering Services NC III;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the TESDA Board in its meeting today, 17 May 2013 at 2:00 p.m., approves and causes to be prioritized the aforementioned qualification titles and approves and promulgates the Training Regulations for Ship's Catering Services NC I, Ship's Catering Services NC II and Ship's Catering Services NC III;


