APPROVING AND PROMULGATING THE TRAINING REGULATIONS FOR BOOKKEEPING FOR SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN FINANCIAL TRANSACTIONS NC II

WHEREAS, Section 2 of the Republic Act No. 11768 entitled 'An Act Strengthening the Sangguniang Kabataan, Institutionalizing Additional Reforms to Revitalize Youth Participation in Local Governance and by Providing Honorarium, Other Benefits, and Privileges, Amending for the Purpose Certain Sections of Republic Act No. 10742, otherwise known as the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015" amended the qualifications of an elected or appointed official of the Sangguniang Kabataan;

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 11768 requires for the appointed Sangguniang Kabataan treasurers to undergo a mandatory bookkeeping training from, and be duly certified by, the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA) before assumption to office;

WHEREAS, Section 14 (b) of Republic Act No. 7796 mandates that TESDA shall develop and establish a national system of skills standardization, testing and certification and conduct research and development on various occupational areas in order to recommend policies, rules and regulations for effective and efficient skills standardization, testing and certification system in the country;

WHEREAS, the National Youth Commission initiated the development of Training Regulations (TRs) for Bookkeeping for Sangguniang Kabataan Financial Transactions NC II;

WHEREAS, the scope of the work of new TR for Bookkeeping for Sangguniang Kabataan Financial Transactions NC II involves maintain records of financial transactions, handle disbursement and payment, and process procurement and inventory supplies, materials and equipment;

WHEREAS, the industry experts and partners, headed by National Youth Commission with the technical assistance of the Qualifications and Standards Office (QSO) of TESDA have developed the aforementioned TR and endorsed the same for TESDA Board approval;

- (2) All programs to be registered under this new Training Regulations must comply with the requirements of the aforementioned Training Regulations. The registration under this new Training Regulations shall commence on the date of effectivity as indicated in the Implementing Guidelines/TESDA Circular for the deployment of the Training Regulations to be issued by the TESDA Secretariat; and
- (3) Graduates of TVET programs covered by the aforementioned Training Regulations shall be required to undergo mandatory assessment under the national assessment and certification program.
