



The Future of Work and Economy for Filipino Migrant Tech-Voc Workers in Qatar

LABOR MARKET INFORMATION | 2024

I. BACKGROUND

Qatar, a Middle Eastern nation, has evolved from a British protectorate reliant on pearling to a wealthy state with substantial hydrocarbon revenues. Governed by the Al Thani family since the mid-1800s, it saw significant reforms under former Amir Hamad bin Khalifa Al Thani, who liberalized media and established Al-Jazeera. His son, Amir Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, continues these reforms, enhancing healthcare, education, and infrastructure for events like the 2022 FIFA Men's World Cup.

Qatar's economy is dominated by **petroleum and natural gas reserves**. The **industrial sector, including liquefied natural gas, crude oil production, refining, petrochemicals, and steel manufacturing, is a major employment source**. The service sector, particularly financial services and real estate, also contributes significantly. Strategic investments in infrastructure and its location on the Persian Gulf bolster economic stability and growth.

Geographically, Qatar is a flat, arid peninsula bordered by Saudi Arabia, with hot summers and mild winters. Doha, the capital, is the economic and population center. The National Vision 2030 aims to diversify the economy, reduce hydrocarbon dependency, and promote a knowledge-based economy through advanced technologies and sustainable practices.

Qatar blends tradition and modernity, preserving archaeological sites and heritage while embracing contemporary development. Attractions include neolithic rock carvings, modern skyscrapers, world-class museums, malls, desert adventures, and international sports venues. The country's maritime heritage supports fishing and water sports, offering activities like kayaking, desert safaris, and beach relaxation.

Qatar is known for desert safaris, archaeological sites, forts, Banana Island, the Sheikh Faisal Bin Qassim Al Thani Museum, Al Dhakira Mangroves, horse and camel racing, beaches, hotels, and souqs. With about 13% of global oil reserves and a small population, Qatar is one of the world's richest countries and highly business-friendly, allowing full foreign ownership of local businesses.

II. Focus Sectors

There are thirteen (13) focus sectors in Qatar for investment. These are the following:

1. Agriculture

Qatar's agricultural sector has expanded significantly due to rising food demand from rapid population growth and government initiatives aimed at enhancing food security. Innovations include Public Private Partnerships, automated irrigation, hydroponics, and aquaponics. The country, a regional leader in the Global Food Security Index, is 100% self-sufficient in fresh poultry and dairy. Key developments involve Mahaseel's support for local farmers, WadiWater's atmospheric water generators, and Baladna's large-scale dairy operations. Qatar's National Food Security Strategy promotes advanced agricultural practices like vertical farming to boost self-sufficiency, supported by investments in agritech and biotechnology.

2. Education

Qatar has prioritized the development of its education sector as a key component of its National Vision 2030, aiming to establish a world-class education system. Notable initiatives include the establishment of Education City hosting branch campuses of leading universities and a substantial research fund of \$1.4 billion by the Qatar National Research Fund (QNRF). Qatar Foundation plays a pivotal role in supporting education, research, and community development, while institutions like HEC Paris and Carnegie Mellon University offer diverse educational programs. Additionally, local schools like the International School of Choueifat-Doha and Doha British School provide high-quality education to students from various nationalities, contributing to Qatar's goal of fostering a knowledge-based economy.

3. Energy

The energy sector is pivotal to Qatar's economy, with the country being the largest exporter of Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) globally. QatarEnergy's expansion plans, including the construction of the world's largest LNG project, aim to significantly boost LNG production capacity. Additionally, initiatives like QSTec's polysilicon manufacturing facility and TAWTEEN's supply chain localization program demonstrate Qatar's commitment to sustainable energy practices and attracting investments. Major multinational energy corporations like Shell, Total, ExxonMobil, and Wasco have established significant operations in Qatar, further contributing to the country's energy landscape.

4. Financial Services

The financial services sector in Qatar plays a significant role in the country's economy, ranking 2nd after the hydrocarbon industry. With a sector contribution of approximately 8% of the GDP in 2022, Qatar has positioned itself as a financial hub in the region. The country offers a favorable climate for business and investment, supported by government-backed incentives like zero tax on personal income and tax holidays. Initiatives like Qatar FinTech Hub aim to foster innovation in the sector, aligned with the goals of Qatar National Vision 2030. Major financial institutions like Ernest & Young (EY), UBS, Credit Suisse, HSBC, and Avenirum have established a presence in Qatar, further enhancing its financial services ecosystem.

5. Healthcare and Life Sciences

The healthcare sector in Qatar ranks 1st in the Arab world, with an expected growth to \$12 billion by 2024. Aligned with Qatar National Vision 2030, investments in state-of-the-art healthcare infrastructure and technologies have been made to develop a healthy population. Notable institutions like Aspetar, Qatar's first specialized Orthopaedic and Sports Medicine Hospital, and the Primary Health Care Corporation (PHCC) play pivotal roles in delivering high-quality healthcare services. Qatar's burgeoning pharmaceutical market, along with opportunities in vaccine manufacturing, further highlights its potential for investment. Elegancia Healthcare, Qatar German Medical Devices, and QLife Pharma are among the key players in the healthcare and life sciences ecosystem.

6. Logistics and Transport

Qatar's logistics and transport sector stands out globally with leading carriers like Qatar Airways Cargo and Qatar Airways, as well as top-notch infrastructure such as Hamad International Airport and Hamad Port. With a market valued at around \$9.9 billion and investments driving significant growth, Qatar ranks 2nd in the region for efficient logistics services. Major projects like the expansion of Hamad International Airport and the electrification of public transit buses demonstrate the country's commitment to sustainability and innovation. Industry giants like Delivery Hero, Uber, DHL, and UPS are already active in Qatar, further enhancing the country's position as a global logistics hub.

7. Manufacturing

Qatar's manufacturing sector is pivotal to its economic diversification efforts, aligned with Qatar National Vision 2030. With a significant contribution of \$21.7 billion to the GDP in 2022, Qatar is aiming to become a global hub for production, leveraging its talent pool, market access, and state-of-the-art free zones. Initiatives like QNRF Smart Manufacturing, QDB Factory One, and QDB Jahiz are driving innovation and supporting local entrepreneurs. Qatar offers lucrative opportunities in high-tech areas like electric vehicles, aerospace additive manufacturing, medical consumables, and vaccine manufacturing, attracting global players like Inventus Power and Gaussin.

8. Media

Qatar's media sector is rapidly growing, supported by state initiatives and hosting major media and telecommunications companies. With Al Jazeera and BeIN networks as powerhouses, Media City Qatar aims to become an international hub for media, technology, and communications. Northwestern University in Qatar offers top-ranked media education programs, while the Al Jazeera Media Institute provides training courses. Qatar is also embracing gaming and eSports opportunities, leveraging its advanced ICT infrastructure and young population. Companies like beIN Media Group, Al Jazeera, Euronews, and Bloomberg are already established in Qatar, contributing to its burgeoning media ecosystem.

9. Professional Services

The professional services sector in Qatar has witnessed substantial growth, contributing \$6 billion to the economy in 2022. This expansion is fueled by increasing local economic activity and Qatar's growing global presence. Sectors such as legal, consulting, accounting, advertising, and IT are experiencing heightened demand, particularly in cross-border regulatory expertise. The Qatar Financial Centre (QFC) offers an attractive platform for domestic and international firms, fostering a transparent and flexible environment for successful operations. Additionally, Qatar is fostering a vibrant ecosystem for technology companies, with numerous coworking spaces and incubators supporting the innovative youth seeking conducive work environments. Key players in the professional services landscape in Qatar include Expense Reduction Analysts, Oliver Wyman, Crowell & Moring LLP, and Wunderman Thompson, reflecting the sector's robustness and appeal in the country.

10. Real Estate

Qatar's real estate sector is experiencing significant growth driven by high GDP growth, population influx, and favorable government policies. The sector's potential has expanded with \$250 billion invested in construction projects and the introduction of property ownership reforms, allowing non-Qataris to invest in real estate for the first time. Notable developments include Lusail City, Downtown Msheireb, The Pearl, Qetaifan Islands, and The Residences at St. Regis Marsa Arabia Island. Key players include China Harbour Engineering Company and Barwa Real Estate Group.

11. Sports

Qatar's sports sector has undergone rapid expansion, particularly following its hosting of the 2022 FIFA World Cup. With initiatives like National Sports Day and the establishment of the region's first sports business district, the country is positioning itself as an emerging international sports business hub. Notable developments include Qatar SportsTech, Sport Accelerator, and Ooredoo Nation - Gamers' Land, reflecting Qatar's commitment to fostering innovation and entrepreneurship in the sports industry. Key players in the Qatar sports ecosystem include Burrda Sport, NSAtech, and FATE Esports, supported by entities like the Ministry of Sports and Youth, the Supreme Committee for Delivery & Legacy, and Aspire.

12. Technology

Qatar presents significant investment opportunities in the technology sector, driven by initiatives like the Smart Qatar Program (TASMU) and collaborations with multinational companies such as Microsoft and Oracle. As the first country to deploy 5G with a 99.7% internet penetration rate, Qatar is positioning itself as a global digitalization leader. Qatar FinTech Hub, QBIC - Digital & Beyond, and Qatar SportsTech are among the specialized incubators and accelerators fostering innovation and entrepreneurship in the country. Entities like Oracle, Microsoft, Siemens, and IBM are actively contributing to Qatar's digital transformation and sustainable growth, aligning with Qatar's vision for the future outlined in Qatar National Vision 2030.

13. Tourism


Tourism in Qatar is rapidly evolving, with the country positioning itself as a premier destination for international visitors. With a focus on hosting major events like the FIFA World Cup 2022 and initiatives, such as the Smart Qatar Program (TASMU), Qatar aims to attract over 6 million international visitors annually by 2030. The country offers visa-free entry for nationals from 100 countries and boasts world-class shopping malls and sustainable urban regeneration projects like Msheireb Downtown Doha. Key players in Qatar's tourism ecosystem include Katara Hospitality, Qatar Museums, and Embrace Doha, all contributing to Qatar's goal of becoming a leading global tourism destination.

III. Key Employment Generators in Qatar

In terms of employment, the figure from World Bank below shows the distribution of employment in Qatar by economic sector from 2011 to 2021. The figure shows that the vast majority of workers in Qatar are employed in the service and industry sectors. In 2021, for

instance, 54% of workers were in industry and 44.8% were in services. The agricultural sector employs a tiny fraction of Qatar’s workforce – just 1.19% in 2021. This distribution has remained fairly consistent over the period shown in the graph, from 2011 to 2021. However, there seems to be a slight decline in the percentage of workers employed in the industry sector throughout the years. On the other hand, the services sector shows a slight increase in the percentage of workers employed.

Based on the figure shown above, it can be assumed that both the Industry Sector and the Services sector have demonstrated resilience and recovery potential due to proactive measures and strategic partnerships despite economic disruptions. For example, despite challenges like the economic blockade and the COVID-19 pandemic, Qatar's industrial sector has displayed resilience and growth, with initiatives such as industrial parks, free zones, and port facilities supporting diversification efforts and providing a consistent flow of employment opportunities. Government oversight by entities like the Ministry of Commerce and Industry and the Qatar Chamber of Commerce and Industry plays a significant role in promoting private sector interests and implementing strategic frameworks like Qatar National Vision 2030. Qatar has also taken steps to attract foreign investment by permitting 100% foreign ownership in most sectors, aiming to boost industrial development and achieve economic diversification. The services sector has emerged as a key driver of Qatar's economic expansion, contributing significantly to GDP growth and employment, making it crucial for economic stability and growth. Qatar’s focus on the industry sector has proven to be an effective strategy being that their economy is dominated by liquefied natural gas, crude oil production, refining, petrochemicals, and steel manufacturing.

A. Employment of Filipino Migrant Workers

According to the data obtained from the Department of Migrant Workers (DMW) as of May 23, 2024, there are 93,751 job vacancies across different sectors in Qatar. The table below shows the top 20 positions with the highest number of job vacancies. The complete positions and number of job vacancies can be found in Annex A.

IV. Qatar National Qualifications Framework

The Qatar National Qualifications Framework (QNQF) serves as a vital tool for organizing both academic and vocational qualifications based on different levels of learning. It is a comprehensive reference system developed with specific criteria, encompassing various educational sectors like academic, vocational, technical, and specialized education. The QNQF is obligatory for all educational institutions, ensuring that both existing and new qualifications are in harmony with its guidelines.

The primary objectives of the QNQF are to enhance qualification quality, facilitate connections between qualifications, and broaden learning and advancement opportunities across different levels. It also facilitates the recognition of current qualifications domestically

and aids in the design of new qualifications. Moreover, the QNQF plays a crucial role in aligning local qualifications with international standards, fostering lifelong learning, and guiding educational system enhancement efforts.

The QNQF is in its final stages of development and awaits approval by the Ministerial Council. Once finalized, its oversight and evaluation will be conducted by the National Commission for Qualifications and Academic Accreditation within the Ministry of Education and Higher Education.

Key steps in implementing the QNQF include:

- Establishing the Office of TVET in 2019 to develop and implement TVET policy;
- Approval of the National Commission for Qualifications and Academic Accreditation by the Cabinet in October 2018;
- Defining the scope and structure of the QNQF;
- Incorporating international standards into vocational education and training initiatives; and
- Customizing occupational standards to fit Qatar's needs.

Currently, each educational institution is linked to a foreign counterpart, alongside the Ministry of Education and Higher Education. This is summarized in the table below. This linkage is established to guarantee quality, relevance, and acknowledgment of TVET-related learning outcomes. Termed "international accreditation," this mechanism undergoes monitoring and evaluation by the Accreditation Board of the respective foreign institutions.

As for their TVET curriculum, the Ministry of Education and Higher Education oversees both academic and TVET curricula. The listed schools and other educational institutions are tasked with developing, updating, and ensuring the quality of their TVET curriculum, guided by the quality assurance organization they collaborate with (Refer to the table in the previous section).

Regarding the adoption of a new accreditation and licensing model, the government has outlined the following action plan:


- Benchmarking against international best practices; and
- Formulating licensing criteria for both existing and prospective institutions.

As of February 2024, the National Committee for Qualifications and Academic Accreditation (NCQAA) continues to host workshops and meetings to improve the national qualifications

framework. This effort is in response to significant changes within the Qatari education system, particularly in the restructuring of Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) access.

V. TVET in the Qatari Education System

As of 2020, the TVET in the Qatari education system is depicted in the figure below:

In Qatar, TVET operates in two (2) systems: Formal and Non-Formal.

1. Formal TVET Systems

- a. For TVET programs offered at the **upper secondary education level (ISCED 3)**
 - i. Duration: 3 years
 - ii. Admission requirements: Completion of Grade 8 Science, English and Maths

- iii. Taught in: Debakey High School for Health Professions, Qatar School of Science and Technology for Boys

Upon completing 9th grade, students have the opportunity to earn vocational certificates tailored to their specialization, including technical and commercial certificates. Subsequently graduating from senior high school, they obtain certificates of graduation or a high school diploma, paving the way for enrollment in technical/vocational schools, community colleges, or CNAQ. Alternatively, students can opt for a foundational year post-high school to prepare for university attendance.

- b. For TVET programs offered at the **post-secondary non-tertiary level (ISCED 4)**
 - i. Duration: 1-3 years
 - ii. Admission requirements: Certificate of successful completion of secondary level, specific achievements in related coursework
 - iii. Taught in: Technical and vocational schools/institutes

The duration of programs ranges from 5 months to 3 years. Upon successfully completing their chosen program, students are awarded either a certificate or a diploma.

- c. For TVET programs offered at the **tertiary level (ISCED 5-8)**
 - i. Duration: 4+ years
 - ii. Admission requirements: Varies by program
 - iii. Taught in: Qatar Community College, Qatar Aeronautical College, Stenden University, College of North Atlantic – Qatar (CNAQ)

Students with certificates or diplomas from vocational training institutions have the option to transfer their credits to a university for formal tertiary education. Likewise, graduates with Bachelor's degrees can advance their studies by pursuing Master's and Doctorate programs.

2. Non-Formal TVET Systems

Currently, there is a focus on formalizing the qualifications system and acknowledging training. Additionally, efforts are underway to develop more programs and facilities that align with the demands of the labor market. This involves consultation and collaboration, including joint ventures with employers. Some examples include the following:

- a. Information Security Awareness Workshop
 - i. Ministry/Organization Responsible: Information Technology Systems Management (Operations Department) Ministry of Education and Higher Education
 - ii. Target Audience: TEDC Specialists
 - iii. Qualifications received: Certificate of Participation

- iv. Entry requirements: Employed as a Training and Educational Development Centre (TEDC) Specialist with the Ministry of Education and Higher Education.
- b. Training on Fires Systems
 - i. Ministry/Organization Responsible: Ministry of Education and Higher Education contract a private organization
 - ii. Target Audience: TEDC Specialists
 - iii. Qualifications received: Certificate of Participation
 - iv. Entry requirements: Employed as a Training and Educational Development Centre (TEDC) Specialist with the Ministry of Education and Higher Education.
- c. Training on the usage of internal and external (cameras) in TEDC premises
 - i. Ministry/Organization Responsible: Technical Support Department – Ministry of Education and Higher Education
 - ii. Target Audience: Secretaries of Heads of Departments
 - iii. Qualifications received: Certificate of Participation
 - iv. Entry requirements: Employed as a secretary of a Head of Department within the Ministry of Education and Higher Education

There are also private companies that offer a variety of training programs to employees, focusing on bridging skills and enhancing capabilities. These initiatives form part of the companies' organizational development and address their human resource requirements.

VI. TVET Capacity

The focus sectors of Qatar were matched with similar or related TVET sectors in the Philippines. The complete list can be found in Annex B, while TESDA programs from the top focus sectors based on the number of job vacancies can be found in the table below:

Based on the data above, half of the positions cannot be directly related to their equivalent TVET sectors as these job titles are not explicitly indicated in the existing TRs. However, if the competencies in the TRs are to be related to the nature of the jobs provided, there are existing TRs that would match them, as provided in the list below:

- Babysitter - Caregiving (Newborn to Pre-Schooler) NC II
- Babysitter House - Caregiving (Newborn to Pre-Schooler) NC II
- Domestic Helper - Domestic Work NC II
- Salesman - Customer Services NC II

Other jobs, namely Nurse, Nurse Private, and Nurse Female, are not addressable by TVET in the Philippines as they necessitate a degree in BS Nursing. Meanwhile, the remaining jobs are too broad to determine their equivalent TRs.

As seen in these data, Qatar is hiring Filipino migrant workers mostly from the TVET sector Social, Community Development, and Other Services, which can be matched with the Professional Services sector of Qatar. Only Driving NC II from the TVET sector Automotive and Land Transportation can supply Filipino migrant workers in Qatar's key economy-driving sector, which is Industry or Manufacturing.

Based on the data on the highest number of vacancies for OFWs in Qatar, TESDA has the capacity in the following areas:

VII. Recommendations

Based on the information provided, the following actions are recommended:

- Alignment through referencing of the Philippine Qualifications Framework with the Qatar National Qualifications Framework for the Philippines to be more adaptable to the employment and training needs of migrant workers in Qatar.
- Collaboration between the Philippines and Qatar in providing skilled workers in the Industry Sector and the Services Sector, particularly with technologies on **petroleum and natural gas reserves, liquefied natural gas, crude oil production, refining, petrochemicals, and steel manufacturing**. Likewise, the identified advanced technologies can be considered in the following programs of TESDA:
 - Implementation of the Adopt-Adapt strategy to develop programs on the advanced technologies for the above-mentioned sectors
 - Development and capacity building of trainers
 - Industry immersion of trainee, as applicable
- Identification of priority sectors in Qatar that have employment opportunities for Filipino migrant workers and reference of the Philippine government in the conduct of training.
