



REQUEST FOR QUOTATION (NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT - TWO FAILED BIDDINGS)

The **Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)**, through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), will undertake a **Negotiated Procurement** for the **Procurement of Photographic Equipment under Lot 2 of the Supply, Delivery, Configuration and Setup of Various Multimedia Equipment for the TESDA Central Office** in accordance with Section 53.1 and Annex "H" of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. (RA) 9184.

TESDA, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) CY 2018 intends to apply the sum of **Three Hundred Twenty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Six Pesos and 27/100 (₱327,486.27)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payment under the contract for the **Procurement of Photographic Equipment under Lot 2 of the Supply, Delivery, Configuration and Setup of Various Multimedia Equipment for the TESDA Central Office**.

Bids shall be submitted in one sealed envelope addressed to the undersigned labelled with the following:

- title of the project;
- name of the Bidder;
- address of the Bidder; and
- contact details of the Bidder.

Interested suppliers are required to submit their respective Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) Certificate of Registration in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR of RA 9184.

TESDA reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of Republic Act No. 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Financial Bid Form (Annex "C") must be duly signed by the bidder or by the authorized representative. All entries must be typewritten or must be legible, if handwritten.
2. The attached Schedule of Requirements (Annex "A"), Technical Specifications (Annex "B") and Financial Bid Form (Annex "C") shall be integral part of the terms and conditions of the contract.
3. Bidders shall provide correct and accurate information required in this form including the Technical Data Sheet or Brochure, as appropriate.
4. Price quotation/s, to be denominated in Philippine Peso shall include all taxes, duties and/or levies payable.
5. Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.
6. Award of contract shall be made to the quotation/proposal which complies with the minimum technical specifications and other terms and conditions stated herein.
7. Offer may be accepted immediately or after some negotiations by TESDA BAC.
8. Any alterations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the bidder or of the duly authorized representative.
9. The TESDA shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods and services to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.
10. Liquidated damage equivalent to one tenth (1/10) of one percent (1%) of the value of the goods and services not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. The TESDA BAC shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.
