

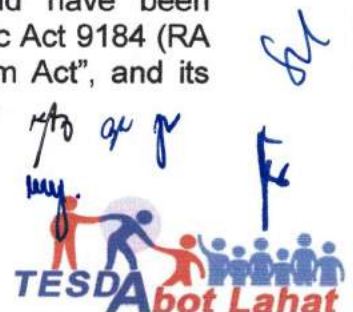


REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE RE-BIDDING OF THE ENGAGEMENT OF A THIRD PARTY ENTITY IN THE PROVISION OF RESEARCH SERVICES FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE EVALUATION STUDY ON THE PROGRAM ON ACCELERATING FARM SCHOOL ESTABLISHMENT (PAFSE)

1. The **Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)**, through the General Appropriations Act (GAA) for FY 2021 intends to apply the sum of **Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Re-bidding of the Engagement of a Third Party Entity in the Provision of Research Services for the Conduct of the Evaluation Study on the Program on Accelerating Farm School Establishment (PAFSE)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The TESDA now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for the **Re-bidding of the Engagement of a Third Party Entity in the Provision of Research Services for the Conduct of the Evaluation Study on the Program on Accelerating Farm School Establishment (PAFSE)**. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **24 August 2021 at 2:00 p.m.** at the **Tandang Sora Hall, TESDA Women's Center, Gate 1, TESDA Complex, Building 2, East Service Road, South Luzon Expressway (SLEX), Fort Bonifacio, Taguig City**. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from the TESDA and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. starting **6 August 2021**.
4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **6 August 2021** from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its



Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR). The short list shall consist of maximum of three (3) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids.

The following criteria shall be considered in the selection/hiring of third party entity in the provision of the required research services in the conduct of the evaluation study:

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6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.

7. The Procuring Entity shall evaluate bids using the Quality Based Evaluation (QBE) procedure.
8. The contract shall be completed within **four (4) months**.
9. The **TESDA** reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
