1	We, [Company Name] together with our Joint Venture Partner, [Company Name], respectfully submit this this request pursuant to Section 21 of Republic Act 9184 or the Government Procurement Law, in relation to the Invitation for Bids issued by TESDA concerning the project named Design and Build of the TESDA Innovation Center with Rehabilitation Works for Region I (RTIC- Tuguegarao, Cagayan Valley) with Contract DI NO. CW301/B. On October 25, 2024, we received the Invitation for Bids of the abovementioned Contract ID. Unfortunately, it does not state the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to be bid. Subsequently, we made several attempts to request for the amount in order to prepare both technical and financial documents yet no amount was given. Upon receipt of the Invitation, we immediately processed the Special License of the Joint Venture with the Philippine Contractors Accreditation Board (PCAB). Alternatively, a Letter of Intent to execute a Joint Venture Agreement in the event of a successful Bid shall be signed by all partners and submitted with the Bid, together with a copy of the proposed agreement. In case the unincorporated JV is the selected bidder, it will be given a maximum of 28 days to apply for and obtain a Special PCAB License for the JV, that is
