For the FY 2021 continuing appropriation, the Construction sector has recorded the overall highest number of scholarship beneficiaries in terms of enrollees (18.52%), graduates (18.40%), assessed (20.59%), and certified (20.79%), followed by the Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) sector - enrollees (17.62%), graduates (17.92%), assessed (20.07%), and certified (20.94%).
