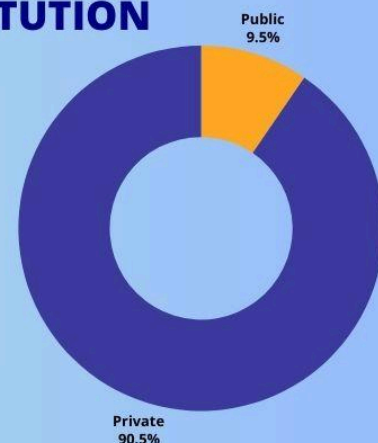

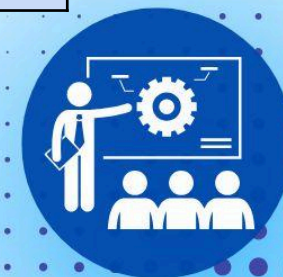

As of November 2024, 100.76% of the target enrollment and 102.19% of the target graduates have been achieved, reflecting an approximate 22% increase from the previous quarter.

In terms of regional accomplishments for enrollment, VIII, XI, and XII recorded an increase of about 40% compared to the previous quarter. Regions XII, IV-A, and VIII also showed an increase of approximately 30% in terms of graduates compared to the previous quarter.

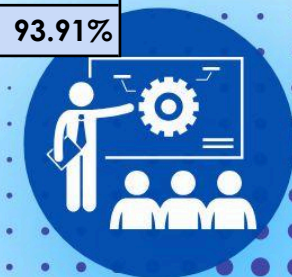

About 120% of the target number of assessed and certified individuals has been recorded for the 4th quarter, reflecting an overall 20% increase compared to the previous quarter.

Moreover, consistent with the previous quarter, NCR leads with the highest percentage accomplishment at 237.19%, followed by Region II at 127.42% and Region X at 126.14%. Similar to assessment accomplishments, NCR, Region II, and Region X also achieved the highest percentage targets for certification.

The national certification rate for the 4th quarter stands at 93.91%. Among the regions, NCR recorded the highest certification rate at 97.85%, followed closely by Region VIII at 96.32% and BARMM at 95.00%.

For the 4th quarter, Table 3 shows significant increases in both enrollment and graduates, reflecting approximately a 20% rise compared to the previous quarter. In terms of delivery mode, Institution-based training programs recorded the highest percentage increase at 28.59%, followed by community-based and enterprise-based programs.

Similarly, institution-based programs also had the highest percentage increase in terms of graduates.

In terms of the number of enrollees across all delivery modes, NCR ranks first, comprising 12.01% of the overall total. This is followed by Region III with an 11.31% share and Region IV-A with 7.98%. For institution-based training programs, NCR recorded the highest number of enrollees, accounting for 15.71% of the total, followed by Region IV-A with 10.70% and Region III with 9.78%. Meanwhile, for enterprise-based training programs, Region IV-A ranked first with a 9.27% share, followed by Region X with 8.88% and Region VIII with 8.86%. In terms of community-based training programs, Region III led with 15.30%, followed by Region XII with 10.23% and NCR with 9.11%. Lastly, for monitored programs, Region IX ranked first with 25.81%, followed by Region I with 11.50% and Region XII with 10.76%.

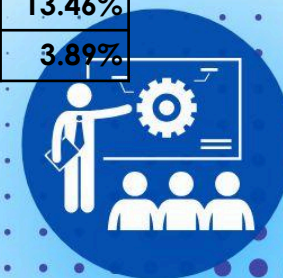

For the sectoral outputs for this quarter the top 5 sectors in terms of total number of enrolled and graduates are: 1) Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) (18.92%) and graduates (18.65%), 2) Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery with enrolled (14.67%) and graduates (14.63%), 3) Social, Community Development and Other Services with enrolled (9.88%) and graduates (9.66%), 4) Automotive and Land Transportation with enrolled (8.00%) and graduates (8.36%) and Electrical and 5) Electronics with enrolled (7.30%) and graduates (7.34%). The high outputs of the sectors mentioned can be attributed to the number of TVET offerings, as these sectors also have the most number of registered programs.

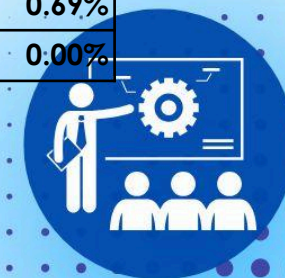
Further, in terms of growth rate in enrollment compared from the previous quarter certain sectors have shown increase such as Footwear and Leathersgoods with 152.69%, Creatives with 127.63%, Wholesale and Retail Trading with 73.18%, and Utilities (Water Supply, Sewerage, Waste Management, etc.) with a 68.04% growth rate.

In terms of assessment and certification, For this quarter the top 5 sectors in terms of total number of assessed and certified are: 1) Tourism (Hotel and Restaurant) with assessed (29.19%) and certified (29.55%), 2) Electrical and Electronics with assessed (12.78%) and certified (12.04%), 3) Social, Community Development and Other Services with assessed (10.65%) and certified (10.37%), 4)Automotive and Land Transportation with assessed (9.92%) and certified (9.23%) and 5) Construction with assessed (8.22%) and certified (8.45%).

Further, in terms of growth rate, several sectors experienced an increase in assessment and certification. Wholesale and Retail Trading has a significant growth with 43.08% in assessment and 44.61% in certification. This was followed by the TVET sector, which grew by 25.62% in assessment and 25.98% in certification. The Construction sector experienced growth rates of 21.23% in assessment and 21.12% in certification. Lastly, the Metals and Engineeringsector saw a growth rate of 20.26% in assessment and 20.18% in certification.

For the 4th quarter of 2024, private TVET providers recorded the highest numbers in both enrollment and graduates, accounting for around 59% of the total output. This reflects an approximate 30% increase in enrollment compared to the previous year's achievement for both public and private providers, and a 27% increase in the number of graduates across both providers.

In terms of regional breakdown, NCR has the highest number of enrollees and graduates in private providers, with 13.77% of enrollees and 14.53% of graduates. This is followed by Region III, with 11.93% of enrollees and 11.62% of graduates, and Region IV-A, with 10.45% of enrollees and 9.56% of graduates.

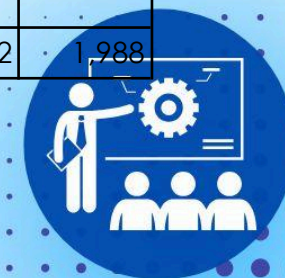

Table 10. Number of Enrolled and Graduates by TTI, by Region and by Sex: 4th Quarter 2024

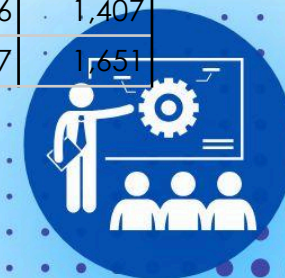

As of this quarter, the Tourism sector leads with the highest number of assessment centers, accounting for 27.18% of the total. This is followed by the Construction sector, which holds a 13.67% share, and the Metals and Engineering sector, comprising 10.75% of the total assessment centers.

In terms of competency assessors, the Tourism sector also ranks first with 24.31%, followed by the Agriculture, Forestry, and Fishery sector with 11.73%, and the Automotive and Land Transportation sector with 11.47%.

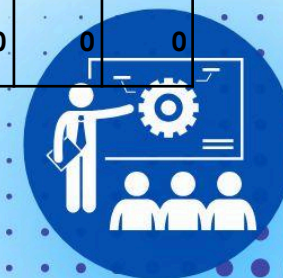

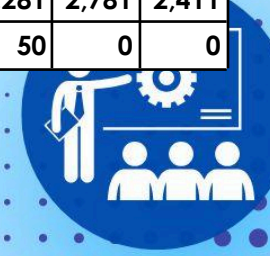

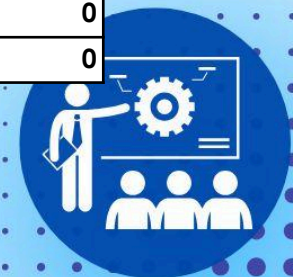

In terms of TVET Infrastructure on registered programs as of November 2024, it can be observed that TESDA Region III has the highest number of registered programs with 2,204, followed by Region IV-A with 1,678, and NCR with 1,460 registered programs.

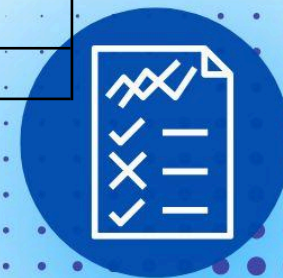
