



Request for Expression of Interest for Employer Satisfaction Survey (ESS) Project

The Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), through the General Appropriations Act CY 2014, intends to apply the sum of **Four Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Pesos Only (Php 465,000.00)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC), to payment under the contract for Consultancy Services for the Conduct of 2014 Employer's Satisfaction Survey. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.

TESDA now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for Consultancy Services for the Conduct of 2014 Employer's Satisfaction Survey. Interested consultants must submit their eligibility documents on or before **30 July 2014 at 10:00 a.m.** at CSA Conference Room, 2nd Floor, TESDA Administration Building, Taguig City. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.

The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those that have submitted eligibility documents and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (RIRR). The short list shall consist of at least three (3) prospective bidders that will be entitled to submit bids.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the RIRR of RA 9184. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.

The procuring entity shall evaluate bids using the Quality-Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS) procedure. The procuring entity shall indicate the weights to be allocated for the Technical and Financial Proposals. The criteria and rating system for the evaluation of bids shall be provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

The contract shall be completed within three (3) months from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed.

TESDA reserves the right to reject any and all bids, annul the bidding process, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
